

Leave the M25 at junction 11. You can then follow the signs to Chertsey but this will mean going through Chertsey town itself.

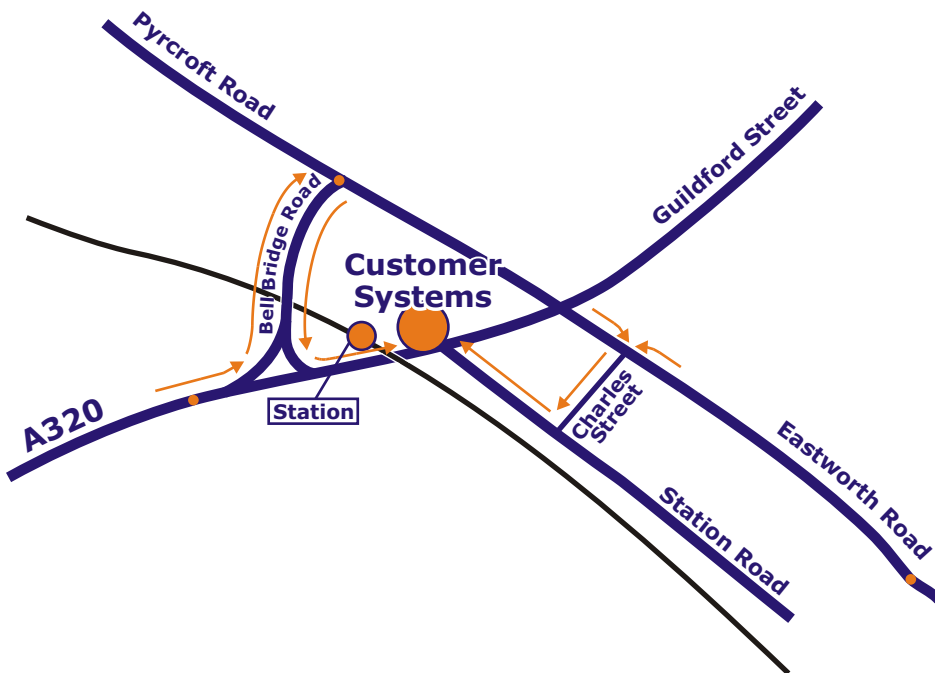
Alternatively, follow the signs for Woking (ie away from London) along a short stretch of dual carriageway until you reach a roundabout where you can turn right onto the A320 towards Chertsey.

As the A320 brings you into the outskirts of Chertsey you will be forced to bend left just before you reach the station. You will then need to do a 180 degree turn around the next roundabout following signs for the station. Still following signs for the station, take the next left into Guildford Road. On the other side of the level crossing, Guildford Road turns into Guildford Street and we are there right beside Chertsey station.

From any part of Chertsey, if you follow signs to the station, you will find us. An alternative route through the rather narrow Charles Street avoids the level crossing as you can see from the map.

There is often space for visitor parking at the rear of our building. Failing that, there is pay-and-display parking at the station and there are streets nearby without yellow lines.

If you are coming by rail, there are direct trains from London Waterloo on the Reading line. There are also some trains from Waterloo to Chertsey where you need to change at Egham or Staines. There is also a rail connection from Weybridge.
